Advantages:

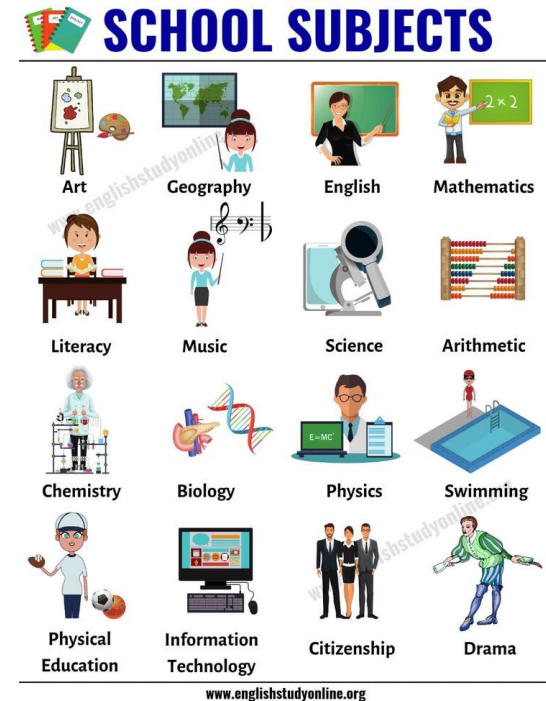
- Everyone wears the same so it is less competitive
